

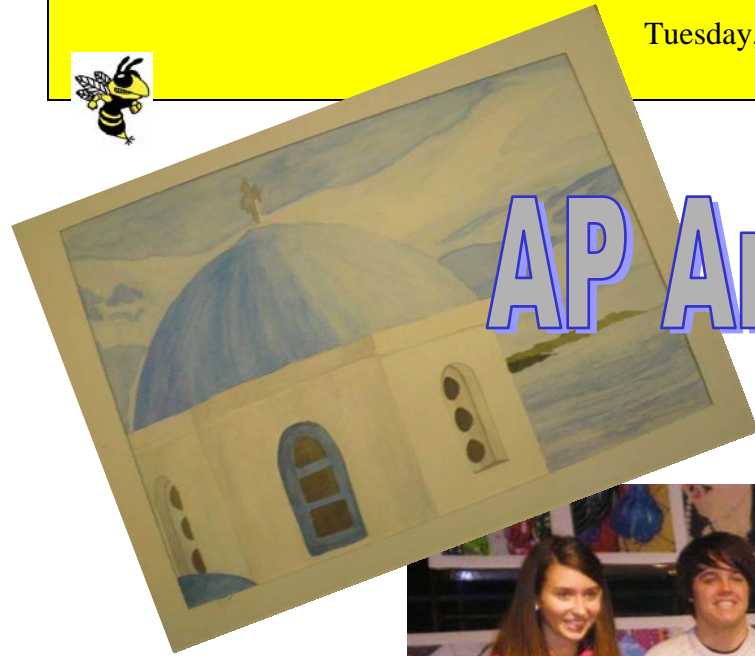

## NATIONAL YOUNG LEADERS STATE CONFERENCE

### Update: Your Scholars at NYLSC

Dear Mrs. Wray,

I am writing to you at the request of Jason Sauer, who contacted me before his departure for the National Young Leaders State Conference (NYLSC) in Columbus. Jason asked that I keep you informed regarding his activities at the Conference this weekend. NYLSC is a four-day leadership conference for high-achieving eighth and ninth graders. Each of the experiential activities in which Jason will participate over the next several days is designed to enhance and nourish his existing leadership skills while challenging him to acquire new ones.

I will be sending you email updates like this one throughout Jason's time at the Conference. I hope to keep you informed through summaries and slideshows of Jason's activities so you know what your nomination means to Jason. Please keep an eye out for my emails.

In his first Leadership Development Meeting, Jason met the other members of his group with some icebreakers. Jason learned that he will be working closely with his group throughout the duration of the Conference, receiving support and encouragement. Jason then proceeded to the "Fuel for an Emerging Leader" exercise. This activity provided him with anonymous feedback collected from members of his community before his arrival at the Conference. This feedback focused on specific areas for improvement—public speaking or adaptability of leadership skills, for example—and provided Jason with the information necessary to set personal leadership goals that he will attain by the completion of NYLSC.
