To register, parents are required to bring the following:

- Child's Original Birth Certificate (w/raised seal, impression on lower corner) baptismal record or passport.
- Parent/Guardian Driver's License or proof of identity.
- Student's Social Security Card.
- Proof of Custody (if applicable).
- Proof of Residency. (A copy of the Proof of Residency must be presented and approved before a student may start school. Examples of a Proof of Residency document include; property owner affidavits, lease agreements, tax bills, and utility bills.)
- Complete Immunization Record. Children who do not meet immunization requirements will not be permitted to attend school.

In the event that any one of these documents is not available at the time of registration, please return the necessary documents and completed forms to Miami Heights Elementary as soon as possible thereafter. What is most important is that parents begin the registration process on March 3, 2007.
