In an effort to keep the lines of communication open regarding the May 8 election, I am including the following letter. Since the district is receiving many phone calls regarding things they are hearing and seeing on signage throughout the district, I want to clarify what the issue is. The issue IS an **EARNED income tax**, which is different from an income tax. Peck, Shaffer, and Williams is the foremost authority on school law in the State of Ohio.

Re: School District Income Tax

Dear John:

Pursuant to your request, we are writing to discuss the one percent school district income tax that will be placed before the voters of the Three Rivers Local School District at the May 8, 2007 election.

The school district income tax that will be placed before the voters is commonly referred to as an "earned income tax". Pursuant to Section 5748.01(E)(1)(b) of the Ohio Revised Code, the income that will be taxed under this option will be "wages, salaries, tips and other employee compensation to the extent included in Ohio adjusted gross income as defined in Section 5747.01 of the Revised Code, and net earnings from self-employment, as defined in Section 1402(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, to the extent included in Ohio adjusted gross income."

This tax will be paid by all residents of the Three Rivers Local School District who have earned income, as defined above. Items that are not included in the tax base for the earned income tax include: retirement income (funds received from IRAs, 401(k) plans, etc.); interest and dividend payments; alimony payments; capital gains received from the sale of real estate, equipment and securities; real estate rental payments; and unemployment compensation and workers compensation payments.

We have attached a recent memorandum from the Tax Analysis Division of the Ohio Department of Taxation entitled "Determining Taxable Income Under the New SDIT Base", along with the state and federal 1040 tax forms referenced therein. This memorandum and tax forms will allow an individual to estimate their tax liability upon the passage of the proposed one percent school district income tax and compare it against the tax liability for a school district income tax calculated on the traditional tax base (Ohio adjusted gross income, less specific exemptions).


