We need YOU !!!! We are looking for community volunteers to work with 5th, 6th and 7th grade students. There are two specific volunteering opportunities available. If you are interested in either opportunity listed below, please contact Deanna Wellens, school psychologist, at 467-3500 or email her at dwellens@three-rivers.org.

-OPPORTUNITY A: Working with a small group of students once or twice per week for 20 minutes (times to be determined) to build reading and/or math skills. Materials needed for a specific intervention will be provided as well as training and assistance as needed.

-OPPORTUNITY B: Helping with an assessment (DIBELS) with 5th, 6th, and 7th grade students during the week of September 10th-14th. You can commit to a couple days or just a couple of hours – whatever works with your schedule. Training is necessary for this, and will be provided. In order to help out with this you will need to attend training on **Thursday September 6th from 3:00 – 4:00** at the middle school. If you would like to help during the week of the 10th-14th but cannot attend the training session, contact Deanna Wellens at 467-3500 or at dwellens@three-rivers.org to schedule an individual training time. *If you helped with DIBELS last year you will not need to attend the training.

** If you have not volunteered in Three Rivers before, you may need to get a background check done at Hamilton County Educational Service Center. There is a \$25 charge for the service which will be refunded by the school.
