## Taylor High School Students Accelerate Past State Average on the ACT

Over the past five years the students from Taylor High School, who have taken the ACT, have increasingly outpaced the state average in all four subcategories of the ACT. For the State of Ohio, Science scores have stayed stagnant, Mathematics and Reading scores increased 1 tenth of a point, and English scores increased 2 tenths of a point. During this same five year period Taylor students have gained 2.2 points in English, 2.3 points in Mathematics, 1.8 points in Reading, and 1.7 points in Science.

In 2001, Taylor students lagged behind the state averages in all four subcategories, but as of the 2005-2006 school year, Taylor students outscored the state average by a substantial margin in all subcategories anywhere from .5 to 1.1 points.
