EXTRACURRICULAR PAY-TO-PARTICIPATE FEES 2007-2008

Sports:

- Taylor \$150 per student-athlete per season—*not sport*
(maximum fee would be \$450 for 3 seasons)
- TRMS \$60 per student-athlete per season (maximum 3 seasons)

Activities:

- Taylor Choir, Band, Drama, Cheerleading (Fall), and Cheerleading (Winter).
\$60 is charged for each of the first 3 activities with a maximum of \$180 per year for the activities listed above.
- TRMS Drama, Cheerleading (Fall), Cheerleading (Winter)
\$30 is charged for each of the first 3 activities with a maximum of \$90 per year for the activities listed above.

All other activities at Taylor are \$8 per activity. These would not count toward the 3 activity maximum, nor would they count into a cap per family (explained below).

All other activities at TRMS are \$8 per activity. These would not count toward the 3 activity maximum, nor would they count into a cap per family.

**Maintaining and verifying records of Extracurricular Pay-to-Participate Fees will be managed by the designated high school secretary.

\$1000.00 Annual Pay-to-Participate Family Cap for combined sport and activity fees for all family members in grades 7-12.

A family (upon reaching the \$1000 cap) will be required to complete a form for the purpose of capping their cost with the next activity or sport. The form can be downloaded from the district website or obtained from the main offices at TRMS or Taylor. The Pay –to-Participate Family Cap Form will require a complete listing of the student's names and the activities and/or sports they have participated in during the current school year. The completed form must be submitted to the Taylor High School Principal's Office. Upon verification of the form, the family and all coaches and activity advisors will be notified of any fee reductions or waivers.

Coaches will be encouraged to fundraise with their teams to help offset pay-to-participate fees.
