## ***Congratulations to Mr. Tom Bailey; the principal of C.T. Young Elementary received the Distinguished Educator for Art Education in the Southwest Area***

This award goes to an individual in Education: not an educator in Art Education; but an educator who has made a significant contribution to Art Education. Mr. Bailey was nominated by Kelly Burichin, Visual Arts teacher at C. T. Young, for his work with the District's Fine Arts Department as an administrative liaison last year, as well as the support he provides now as principal.

As an administrative liaison for Fine Arts meetings, Mr. Bailey exhibited various public relation ideas and ways to spread the word out about the Fine Arts Department consisting of a team of dedicated teachers in C.T. Young's Visual Arts, Music, and Drama department. As a musician and former band director, Mr. Bailey knows the importance and the power of the arts in our students' school experience. On December 8, C.T. Young will host an event called Kids Art Fair: a show where students' artwork is framed and presented as in a gallery show. Proceeds will go towards creating a real art classroom—the classroom is currently in the corner of the cafeteria created by partitioned walls. Burichin says she nominated Mr. Bailey because she believes that “he has big vision and belief that things can always get better than they are.” Mr. Bailey is now in the running for the Distinguished Educator for Art Education award in Ohio.
