Please join the Three Rivers Local School Board at a community meeting TOMORROW, January 5, 2010 at 7pm. The meeting will be at Faith Fellowship on 6734 Bridgetown Road, 45248. The purpose of the meeting is to share information and gather input from community members on the school board's recommendation to pursue the possibility of building a new Pre-K through 12th grade school building. The board made this decision in a special meeting on Monday, December 14 where the land search committee presented its findings after extensive study and cost comparisons.

Tomorrow night the land search committee will share its findings, and there will be roundtable discussions on the opportunity. Everyone who attends will have an opportunity to get their questions answered and their feedback considered. Babysitting and refreshments will be provided. Please encourage your friends, neighbors and family who live in the district to join us at the meeting as well. We want as many people as possible to be aware of the opportunity and provide feedback.

H1N1 Follow-up Clinic to be held in mid- January

Hamilton County Public Health will hold a second round H1N1 vaccination clinic at a central school location (to be determined) in our area in mid-January. The clinic will be open to children nine and under who need a flu vaccination booster (second dose) and also to those school children (Kindergarten through grade 12) who missed the first round vaccination clinic (for any reason). In addition, it is open to all school staff (including teachers, substitute teachers, and all other support staff) who would like to receive the vaccination.

The district will receive more specific information regarding this clinic, including the date, location, appointment time and required paperwork early January. When we have the information we will pass it along accordingly.

Mrs. Erin Metz's French class (right) spread some Christmas cheer before winter break and headed to the Western Hills Retirement Village for caroling—in French of course!



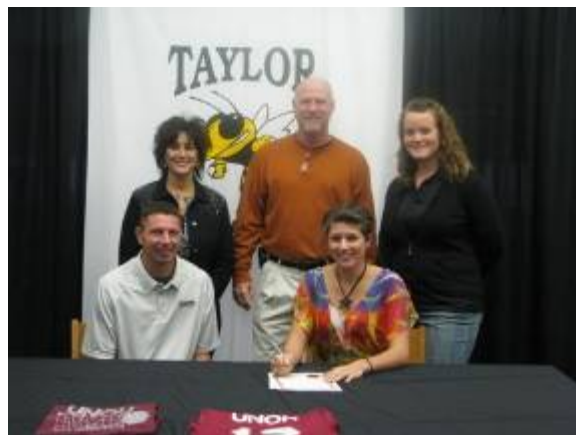
