

**Local Educational Agency Plans [Section 1112](#)
And Parental Notification [Section 3302](#)**

The district must within 30 days of the start of the school year (or within two weeks of placement if not identified prior to the beginning of school), notify parents that their children have been identified as learning English proficiency (LEP) students who will participate in Title I funded LEP programs as determined in [Part C of Title III](#). Parents will be informed of:

- Reasons for child's identification and placement;
- Child's level of English proficiency, how assessed, and status of child's academic achievement;
- Method of instruction used in child's academic achievement;
- Method of instruction used in child's program;
- How the program will meet the educational strengths and needs of the child;
- How the program will help the child learn English and meet age-appropriate academic achievement standards for grade promotion and graduation;
- Program exit requirements, expected rate of transition and expected rate of graduation (if Title III funds are in the secondary school);
- If applicable, how the program meets the child's individual education plan (IEP).
