Dear Parent or Guardian:

Our school district receives federal funds for Title I programs to assist students in reading and mathematics. These programs fall under the jurisdiction of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001. Because this legislation involves many different educational issues concerning your child's education, we plan on providing you with information about this law throughout the school year.

You are entitled to request and receive information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher (s). If you request this information, the district or school will provide you with the following in a timely manner:

1. if the teacher has met state licensing requirements for the grade level and subjects in which the teacher is providing instruction;
2. if the teacher is teaching under an emergency status for which state licensing requirements have been waived;
3. the type of college degree and the major of the teacher as well as the field of discipline for any graduate degree.
4. if your child is receiving Title I services from paraprofessionals and, if so, his or her qualifications.

Currently, Title I services are being provided at Hitchens Elementary and Miami Heights Elementary and all our Title I teachers are state-approved licensed teachers. If you would like to request any of the information above, please contact your child's school. Thank you for your interest and involvement in your child's education.
