

Search for Children with Disabilities

School districts throughout Ohio are participating in an effort to identify, locate, and evaluate children who may be in need of special education and related services.

What are disabilities?

- **From birth to age three-** an established condition known to result in delay or a documented developmental delay.
- **For ages three through five-** a documented deficit in one or more of the following developmental areas: communication, vision, hearing, motor skills, social emotional/behavioral functioning, self-help skills, and/or cognitive skills.
- **For ages five through twenty-one-** identification of one or more of the following conditions: autism, deaf-blindness, hearing impairment including deafness, mental retardation, multiple disabilities, orthopedic impairment, other health impairment, emotional disturbance, specific learning disability, speech or language impairment, traumatic brain injury, and/or visual impairment including blindness.
