Three Rivers' Bond Issue Passes

Residents secure community's future with yes vote

On May 4, 2010, residents of the Three Rivers Local School District approved Issue 9 to build a new Pre-K through 12 school on Cooper Road in Cleves, OH. This new school will serve students for decades to come in a learning environment designed to prepare children for a productive and successful future.

The design process for the new school will begin immediately. If you have expertise, skills, or a keen interest in the design process, please contact the district board office at 513.941.6400 or email Kari Kuh at kkuh@three-rivers.org. The district will form committees to address various aspects of a building's design including the outside and/or structural component, classrooms, community areas, media center, office and conference areas, technology, playfields, parking, and more. Community input is essential for this project.

The design process will take approximately one year and the actual construction of the new school will take approximately two years. The new energy efficient school should be ready to welcome students in the fall of 2013.

In addition to designing the new school, a committee will be formed to investigate and pursue the use of Taylor High School. Possibilities include partnerships, leasing all or portions of the building, or selling the property outright for development purposes.

Committees will also be formed to plan the closing ceremony for each of the schools that are an important part of the rich history and treasured traditions of Three Rivers.

Three Rivers Local School District is excited to embark on this project that will establish a legacy for generations to come.
