

### Three Rivers Local Schools

This information is being presented due to C.T. Young not meeting Adequate Yearly Progress in one or more subgroups in 2006-2007 and is mandated by “No Child Left Behind”.

In school year 2007-2008, 225 students were eligible to receive supplemental educational services (SES) from Three Rivers due to C.T. Young not meeting Adequate Yearly Progress in one or more subgroups during the 2006-2007 school year. Out of 225 eligible students, 195 students participated. Students from both C.T. Young and Miami Heights were included for SES. Eligibility for SES is based on qualifying for free or reduced lunch.

There were no PSC (public school choice) schools offered because Three Rivers has centralized schools and no adjoining school district had open enrollment.

The services, individual and small group tutoring, were offered at Miami Heights Elementary School and C.T. Young Elementary School. The service providers were regular classroom teachers and Title I teachers. The services took place after school at C.T. Young, and at Miami Heights services were provided before school and during transitional times throughout the school day.
