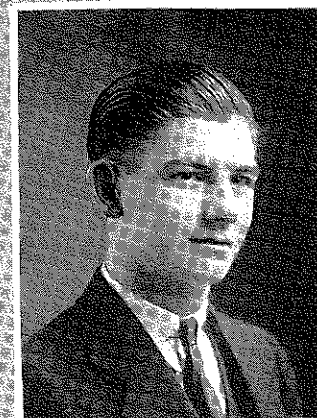

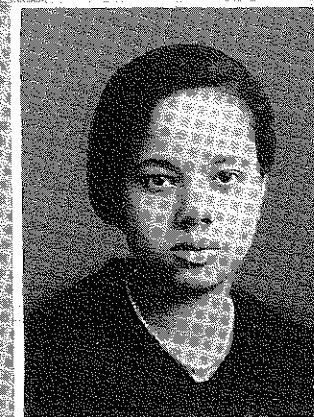

INEZ BAILEY —Inez

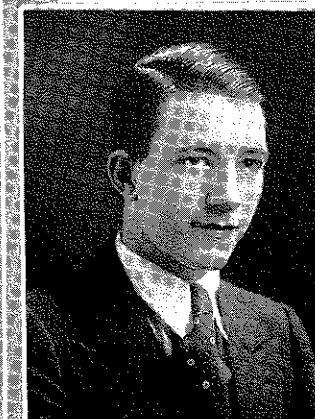
Inez m'nds her own business and does not have much to say, but there are very few things that can keep her away from school.

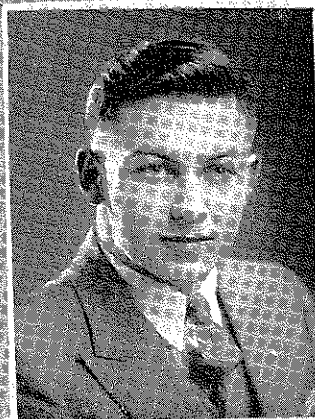

LILLIAN MCKEEVER—Keever

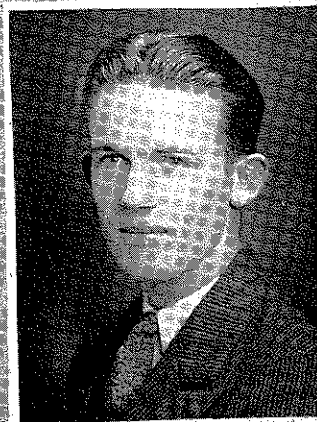
Keever is always ready for a good argument and hard to convince but she never loses her self-control and her pleasant way of looking at things.

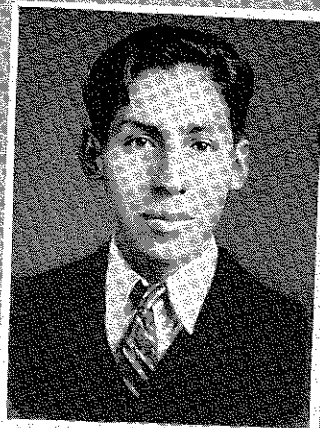


ROBERT HORTON—Bobby

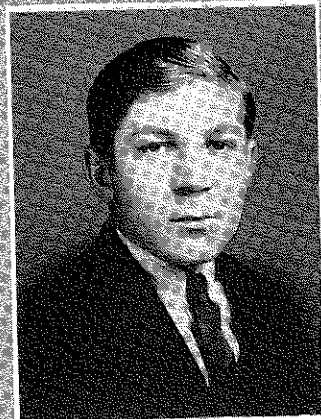

ROBERT MOCK—Bruvver

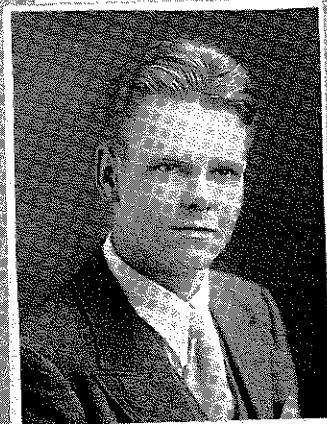
Bruvver with the perseverance which he possesses when he cares to use it, usually comes out on the top.

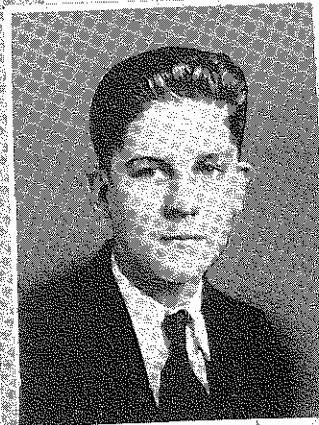
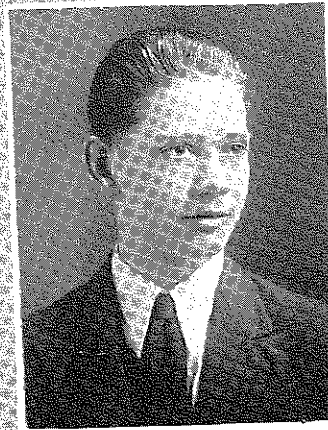

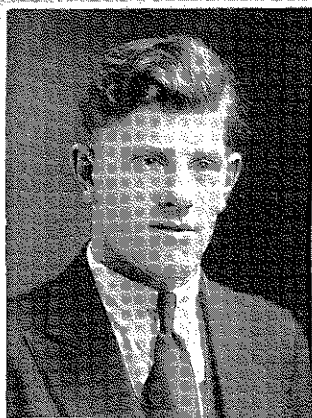
MILDRED WOOD—Mil
