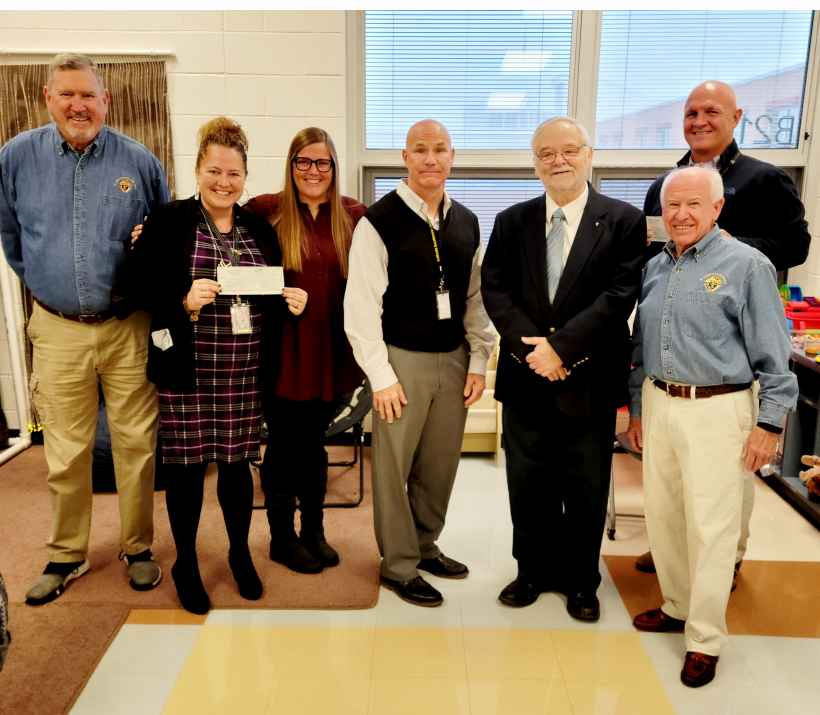


THANK YOU, KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS!
