WORK SESSION TOPICS

- A.** Proposed Village of Cleves Income Tax – The proposed 1% income tax was discussed as well as the impact it would have on the staff of Three Rivers. Further meeting will be held for public discussion on the topic at the Cleves Board Office on May 13, June 10, and July 8.
- B.** Presidents Federal Credit Union contacted Mr. Sies about a partnership opportunity with the Three Rivers Local School District for a co-branded credit card. This partnership would raise revenue of \$1,000 per credit card opened for the next 2 years while the program grows. After that it would be a negotiated percentage.

- C.** LED proposal for TREC – Mr. Smiley is researching the potential cost saving benefit of converting all of the lights on the Three Rivers Education Campus to LED. All areas with the exception of the Auditorium would be eligible to use the OFCC 034 Classroom Facilities Fund to cover the expense. The Auditorium would need to be generated through the general fund. Mr. Smiley will reach out to get some pricing information and will report back to the BOE at a future meeting.
