1. Introduction of New Members

- 2. Update from the Boosters regarding athletic building/space needs & improvement plans
 - a. They plan to have a subcommittee in place to support private fundraising
 - b. Larry Herges is working on getting HS coaches together to gather needs after the Fall seasons end tentatively sometime in early November
 - c. The Boosters are gauging the interest in building on-campus
 - d. They are ready for next steps i.e. renderings, drawings.. budgets, etc
 - e. All utilities are already available at the site next to the current concession stand.
- 3. TRLSD Open Enrollment Overview
 - a. The board policy has been in place since 2005
 - b. We currently have 234 students open-enrolled students
 - c. The students are spread out among the K-12 grade levels.
 - d. Administrators determine if there is availability for acceptance at each grade level prior to the June 1st application period.
 - e. The policy maintains that additional staff will not be hired to address the increase in enrollment.
 - f. Students enrolled under the policy will be monitored regularly for attendance, behavior and grades.
 - g. Currently, state funding for open enrollment students is the same as traditional students so the District receives about \$500,000 for these students. The additional enrollment does take the District out of the guarantee system which in turn provides additional state funding.
 - h. We will continue to monitor how the state funds districts, how much space constraint we are under, kdg. registration, and student engagement

 - a. 10-year projection Shows a gradual increase for the next ten years for a total increase projected at 216 students
- 5. Elevar Architectural Firm Lisa Cameron Gulley/Dave Hester: Overview of the Original TREC Building Plan
 - a. Architects Lisa Gulley Cameron & Dave Hester provided an overview of the original building project
 - b. Reviewed the original concept of the athletic bldg for the space next to the concession.
 - c. The courtyard very difficult for expansion b/c of fire code, construction, and daylight requirements
 - d. Built for approximately 1,950 students our current enrollment is 2,190
 - e. Projected to increase to 2300
 - f. 10.7M+ to get CTY back to OFCC standards/codes (to allow us to provide instruction for our students in this building again)
 - g. Potential spaces for Academic Expansion include an extension of the existing third floor, the 7th/8th grade Entrance, and extending the Elementary wing into the parking lot
