Virtual Academy Update

- 14 families are transitioning to virtual academy for the second semester.
- 70% of Final Forms Letter of Intent Completion – all incomplete forms result in families staying the same as 1st Quarter.
- Overall, Virtual Academy is going well. Systems/Schedules are in place.

-ODE brought the Literacy Plan to Three Rivers in the 2019-2020 school year.

-Working to ensure Strategic Plan and Literacy Plan work together.

-Currently planning for implementation of the Literacy Plan for the 2021-2022 school year.

-Discussion of how grammar is taught in the classroom district-wide. Joan is looking into standards around grammar.

-Discussions about the Literacy Plan were whole-district – broke off into buildings – came back together to discuss.

State Benchmark Assessments

- State used funds to help build a platform for assessments.
- Full-length, live assessments were built – to mimic what tester will see in the same format as the actual test – gives teachers results accurate to the real test results
- THS will do some of this work in place of some exams (Alg 1/Eng 2)
- Looking at a new intervention model (interventions in place of advisory) using data from new platform.
- Joan believes this will be a great data source for the district to use.

THS Pathways

- How to showcase our student options so that families are aware of all opportunities.
- Video clips will be created to share all student options (menu board option).
- Working with a consultant for career academies – connecting to CCP after some coursework through Taylor.
- Discussion about the benefits of CCP and the importance of all Taylor students understanding these options.
- Interview students who already went through the CCP program so that they can educate students who may be considering taking CCP courses.
