WORK SESSION TOPICS

Athletic Programs. 48% of the student body is currently participating in the sports program compared to the average which is approximately 30%. (Fall Cumulative GPA was 3.45; Winter Cumulative GPA 3.18) Spring will be updated at the end of the season. While we have some room to grow our athletes are doing well in the classroom. The girls have consistently stepped up in all areas this year with outstanding records, especially Volleyball, Swimming, Bowling, Basketball and Girls Wrestling. The boys teams have also performed well this year, especially in Wrestling, Bowling, Swimming and Basketball all finishing strong. We are looking forward to a great Spring Season. There were multiple school records broken this year. We have had 4 players of the year and 3 coaches of the year in the CHL.
