#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

- Academic/Curriculum Mr. McDonald and Dr. Stafford reported on the curriculum committee's activities, including discussions on AI, civil data, and math interventions; the creation of a toolkit to help teachers understand the appropriate use of AI in the classroom and improvements in K-1 math and the use of strategies to help students understand concepts better. Also discussed was the importance of federal funding and the need to ensure resources are approved by the district.
- Buildings and Finance Mrs. Riesenberg provided an update on revenue from property tax and TIF money, noting that both came in on time and higher than forecasted. We also discussed the impact of legislative changes on school funding and the energy bills. Dr. Ault discussed the plan to cover all-day kindergarten costs for families through the SGO and provided an update on the athletic training center.
- Community Liaison Mrs. Hughes reported on various community activities, including baccalaureate, summer student camps, and end-of-year banquets.



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Mrs. Hughes also highlighted the success of the jacket games and the positive impact on the community; the upcoming graduation and the 100th year celebration for Taylor High School. She also discussed the success of the high school musical and the announcement of the next year's musical.
