



# Building and Grounds Meeting – Three Rivers and TDG 9/04/19

# **Forward Edge**

William and Dave from Forward Edge shared the following regarding the technology infrastructure at Three Rivers. Three systems that were designed and installed into Three River's campus are approaching the end of their usable life, PA/Intercom, Video Surveillance, and Access Control. There are a few major reasons for this:

- -Technology that was installed into the building was spec'd and manufactured during the construction process and are in reality at or beyond 10yrs old.
- -Demands of technology change in regards to improving safety.
- -The foundation of the technology that was installed (the servers and software running them) are simply becoming less reliable with age.
- -Lastly, the systems that were installed are proprietary and closed by design. This limits the number of options when it comes to repair and updates.
  - PA/Intercom: this system was designed for basic functionality and does not allow for functions that school districts and School Resource Officers see as valuable. Additionally, this system can only be supported by one vendor in the area and this is causing delay in repair. Installing a new IP based PA/Intercom system will solve immediate safety issues and allow for better functionality in the case of an emergency.
  - Video Surveillance: The district currently has dozens of cameras that are not functioning. The primary cause for this is servers that are beginning to fail. In addition, the closed system software running the cameras is outdated and extremely costly to update. Updating the software would not fix the server issues. We would recommend replacing the servers and moving to a more open software that would save money in long-term support of the system.
  - Access Control: The access control system is currently functioning at an acceptable level. It is worth
    noting that this system interconnects to the other systems and is also becoming outdated.
    Although last on the priority list, this system will need updated in the not-too-distant future. The
    new system would use the existing locks, badge readers, etc., but would be easier to use to
    ensure the right people have access to the building.

  - HVAC Fall PM's to begin Sept with Peck. Will provide start date for Jeff.


- o All HVAC filters were replaced in Aug by TDG.

    - Need to complete and confirm as built drawings for our files. (no further work onsite)






