HB21	Community Schools - verification of community school enrollments.	<p>Pending House Education and Career Readiness Committee.</p> <p>The House Education Committee heard sponsor testimony Tuesday on House Bill (HB) 21 from Rep. Steve Hambley (R- Brunswick). This legislation deals with the verification of community school enrollments.</p>
HB37	School Safety-Structures - To require the Ohio School Facilities Commission to establish a program assisting school districts in purchasing technology and making physical alterations to improve technology infrastructure and school safety and security.	<p>Pending House Education and Career Readiness Committee.</p> <p>The committee heard sponsor testimony on HB 37 from Rep. Steven Arndt (R- Port Clinton). This bill would require the Ohio School Facilities Commission to establish a program to help districts purchase technology and make physical alterations to improve technology infrastructure and school safety and security.</p>
SB 8	School Infrastructure and Technology - To require the Ohio School Facilities Commission to establish a program assisting school districts in purchasing technology and making physical alterations to improve technology infrastructure and school safety and security.	<p>Pending Senate Education Committee.</p> <p>The Senate Education committee heard sponsor testimony on Senate Bill (SB) 8 from Sen. Randy Gardner (R-Bowling Green). This legislation also would require the Ohio School Facilities Commission to establish a program to help districts purchase technology and make alterations to improve technology infrastructure and school safety and security.</p>
SB 9	August Tax Holiday - Exempts sales of clothing and school supplies and instructional materials from sales and use taxation during August 4, 5, and 6, 2017.	<p>Passed the Senate. 32-1. It is now pending in the House Ways & Means Committee</p>

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SB36	<p>Agricultural Land - To require that the computation of the capitalization rate for the purposes of determining CAUV of agricultural land be computed using a method that excludes appreciation and equity buildup and to stipulate that CAUV land used for a conservation practice or enrolled in a federal land retirement or conservation program for at least three years must be valued at the lowest of the values assigned on the basis of soil type.</p>	<p>Pending Senate Ways and Means Committee.</p> <p>The Committee heard proponent testimony.</p>
SB54	<p>Summer Food Programs - To require school districts to allow approved summer food service program sponsors to use school facilities to provide food service for summer intervention services under certain conditions.</p>	<p>Pending Senate Government Oversight and Reform Committee.</p> <p>The committee heard sponsor testimony on SB 54 from Sens. Edna Brown (D-Toledo) and Peggy Lehner (R-Kettering). This bill would require districts to allow approved summer food program sponsors to use school facilities to provide food service for summer intervention services.</p>
SB34	<p>School Years - To generally require public and chartered nonpublic schools to open for instruction after Labor Day.</p>	<p>Pending Senate Education Committee</p> <p>The committee heard sponsor testimony from Sen. Gayle Manning (R-North Ridgeville) on SB 34. This legislation would require schools to open for instruction after Labor Day unless the board of education holds a public hearing and passes a resolution to start school at an earlier date.</p>
