

2019-2020 Fall Musical Information Packet— Kids Cast



IN ORDER TO AUDITION

- 1) fill out the attached application with parent/guardian signatures to bring to your audition
- 2) sign up for an audition time outside of Ms. Hannon's door (B218) or fill out the attached "Audition Time Slot Request" form and submit to Ms. Hannon by Friday, September 13th
- 3) prepare the portion of "A Christmas Song" from Elf Jr. as specified on the sheet music included in the Cast Information Packet
- 4) get two teacher/coach/mentor recommendations (sheets attached) and turn them in to Ms. Hannon (**recommendation sheets need to be turned in ONLY if you did not participate in *Beauty & the Beast Jr.* or *Junie B. Jones Jr.***)

****Any parents of younger students that are not able to sign up for an audition time on their own should turn in the attached "Audition Time Slot Request" form included in the Cast Information Packet or email Ms. Hannon at ehannon@trlsd.org to secure an audition time.**

AUDITIONS: Tuesday, September 17th from 3:40 - 5:30 PM

Auditions will be closed, meaning that parents and other students will not be allowed to watch. It is each auditioning student's responsibility to sign up for an audition time, to show up at that time, and to have their transportation arranged for that time. Results will be posted at the end of the week of auditions.

PLEASE NOTE

Casting for Elf Jr. will be selective. Approximately 40 elementary students will be selected for the production. All casting decisions are final. Judges scores will remain confidential and will not be posted. Casting placements will not be debated or discussed once the final cast decision is made. Negative or jealous comments from parents/students regarding cast members or their placements will not be tolerated, and will result in the cast member being released from the play. Please understand that not everyone who auditions will be cast.

WHO CAN AUDITION?

All Kindergarten through 4th grade students (2019-20 school year) who are in good behavioral/academic standing may audition. In accordance with the Three Rivers Educational Campus extracurricular code of conduct policy, participation in extracurricular activities (which includes the school musical) is dependent upon the following: **you must be in good academic standing, have a good school attendance record, and follow the school and district code of conduct. The administration may withdraw this privilege at any time.**




