## Three Rivers Elementary - April 2020 Newsletter

Dear families,

Thank you for your patience and cooperation during this unprecedented time. Two weeks ago I couldn't imagine leaving school for 3 weeks, but now we are facing a 5-week absence from school with the possibility of longer. During this time of uncertainty, our school community has rallied to engage in extraordinary ways. Students took home packets of work before they left, but that was just the start. Since we left school:

- our staff recorded 35 read aloud videos so students can hear stories in our voices (<u>linked here</u>)
  our students have viewed those videos almost 2,000 times!
- Our staff was able to reach over 700 families by phone for a check-in
- Classes have started video conferencing to remain in "face-to-face" contact
- Staff and Community members have delivered food every Monday, Wednesday and Friday to ensure basic needs are still being met.

Now our teachers are preparing to engage in instruction beyond the packets that were sent home. We don't know if Governor DeWine will close schools, but we are preparing activities just in case. Please remain patient with us as we learn through this process as well. As we move into remote learning activities on April 6, our primary goal at the elementary is to provide meaningful activities to help you structure learning at home. We want students to continue to learn, but this will look different than a typical school week...and that is okay! Students will receive assignments, but will also be encouraged to learn and explore their own interests. You can expect to receive more information from teachers next week about communication and activities. Until then, I will leave you with similar advice I gave to our teachers: Breathe...There is no pressure to be an "Instagram" Online or Homeschool Teacher/Parent. None of us signed up for this. We will all do our best to make the best of this situation; we are in this together. Connection to our school community is the most important thing we can do! We are better together! And, remember to wash your hands! Stay Healthy!

### **TRLSD Resource Distribution**

In response to the Governor's mandated school closure to slow the spread of COVID-19, Three Rivers has a group of local organizations and volunteers that are working diligently to continue nutrition services for our students who qualify for free and reduced lunch.

#### The Plan to Serve Our Families:

2-day lunch and breakfast packs will be provided to students on Free and Reduced Lunch. **NEW INFORMATION:** Due to federal guidelines, students **MUST** be present to receive food. If this is not possible, please let us know at the distribution site and we will work to meet your individual needs if possible. During distribution stops, the School Nurse's Office and Miami Township Fire Department will be providing information and educational resources concerning COVID-19. Additionally, we value the importance of reading and will be offering free books to children of all ages and adults. The schedule below is estimated but every effort will be made to follow the timeline as closely as possible.
