# Safety Protocols

- Social Distancing

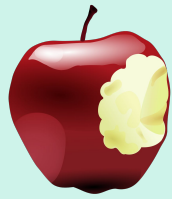


# Quarantine Protocol

**Be prepared with a plan for your child to be home in the case of a positive COVID-19 identification.**

- A student who tests **positive** will need to be quarantined for 10 days AND be symptom free for 72 hours prior to returning to school.
- A student who is identified as a **close contact** will be quarantined for 14 days.
  - A close contact was within 6 ft of the positive case for 15 minutes during a 48 hour period.

\*Quarantined students will be able to complete work via Accelerate Education.



# Lunch Procedures

- All seats will be facing 1 direction
- We will be using the entire cafeteria (previously used half of the cafeteria)
- Seats will be assigned based on class color and number
- We will rotate classes in to allow faster cleaning
- We strongly encourage packing lunch when possible
- Peanut Free Table will be provided as well



# Recess Procedures

- Cohorting at Recess
  - Each class plays in separate areas of the playground (grass area, blacktop, courtyard, etc)
  - Teachers will take classes outside

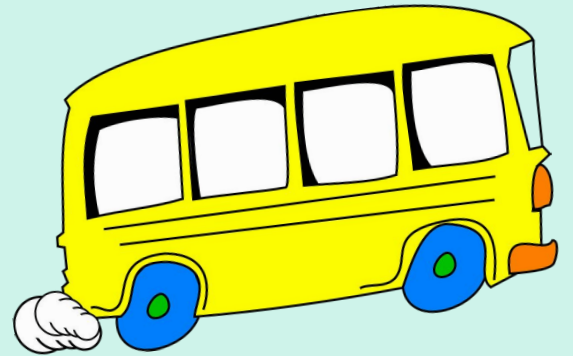


# Visitors to the Building and Field Trips

- Teachers will assign modules/lessons to complete on Wednesday



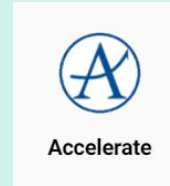

# Water Bottles and Drinking Fountains

- Drinking Fountains are turned off around the building
- Students should bring a refillable water bottle



# Arrival

- The lobby doors will unlock at 8:30 am for elementary arrival.
- Students will not be permitted to be dropped off unsupervised prior to 8:30 am and should remain in the care of a parent/guardian/caretaker.
- Students will report directly to their classrooms.
- If they are eating breakfast, they will grab a breakfast from the cafeteria and go directly to their classrooms.
- Students in PreK-1st grade need to wear the name tag given at open house for the first day of school. These name tags will correlate with your child's homeroom.



# Dismissal for Car Riders

- We use both traffic circles for afternoon pick up
  - ELEMENTARY CIRCLE PICK UP
    - Preschool, Kindergarten, 1st Grade (and older siblings/car riders), you will enter the elementary entrance by the marquee sign
  - HIGH SCHOOL CIRCLE PICK UP
    - 2nd, 3rd, & 4th Grades, you will enter the high school circle and pick up your child
