

Future 12th Grade Course Selection Worksheet

Please use this scheduling worksheet to guide you in the selection of courses for the 2021-2022 school year. Students and parents/guardians should consider previous school records and teacher recommendations when choosing a course. Taylor High School offers several levels of instruction to meet the academic needs of students.

The levels below are listed in the order of difficulty.

Advanced Placement (AP) or College Credit Plus (CCP)

Seniors must have at least 5 credit classes. Seniors are allowed to take 5 bells of classes and leave 2 bells early if their schedule and graduation credit requirements allow.

Students taking CCP courses may have less than 5 bells marked depending on the college courses they are taking. Students should work closely with their counselor to communicate their CCP Schedule.
