FALL SPORTS SEASON RECAP

During the Fall Sports Season:

- 231 students filled the 9-12 rosters.
- 83% of those students (193 out of 231) had a GPA of 3.0 or higher during the Fall grading period.
- 167 students earned a Varsity letter during the fall season.
 (72% who participated)
- 81% of those students (136 out of 167) earned a GPA of 3.25 or higher.
- 51 students earned a perfect 4.0 GPA.
