

#### February 25 - ACT Testing

On February 25, all Taylor High School Juniors will be taking the ACT test. This test is used for college entrance and also is an important part of the Prepared for Success Measure of our state report card. On Tuesday, January 28th, the Three Rivers Board of Education moved to amend the district calendar to make this a school day for juniors only (freshmen, sophomores, and seniors do not report to school on this day). This will ensure that we provide our students with an optimal testing environment, allow for small group testing for all students, better equip our staff to provide accommodations for students as indicated in IEPs and 504 plans, and eliminate any issues of interruptions of the test. We will send a more detailed schedule of this day to all juniors prior to the testing date.
