


I cannot thank you all enough for your incredible support during this difficult time. I will continue to update you all in a weekly video so that we stay on the same page throughout our time of school closure.



# TRLSD Resource Distribution

In response to the Governor's mandated school closure to slow the spread of COVID-19, Three Rivers has a group of local organizations and volunteers that are working diligently to continue nutrition services for our students who qualify for free and reduced lunch.

### The Plan to Serve Our Families:

Two-day lunch and breakfast packs will be provided to all students currently on Free and Reduced Lunch. During distribution stops, the School Nurse's Office and Miami Township Fire Department will be providing information and educational resources concerning COVID-19. Additionally, we value the importance of reading and will be offering free books to children of all ages and adults.
